

TIMELINE FEDERAL ELECTIONS GERMANY 2017



September 24 Election Day

Polling stations open at 8:00 a.m. sharp and at 6:00 p.m. they close again.



October 24 The 19th Bundestag convenes

The newly elected Parliament must meet for the first time no later than one month after the election.



December 2017 / January 2018 Government in place

The new Government will take on its responsibilities.



September 25 Exploratory Talks* and Coalition Negotiations

The final result is announced. The exploratory talks among parties commence. They will lead into coalition negotiations with open end dates.



November 24 Everything fair-and-square?

If anyone wants to challenge the validity of the election, they have two months to do so.

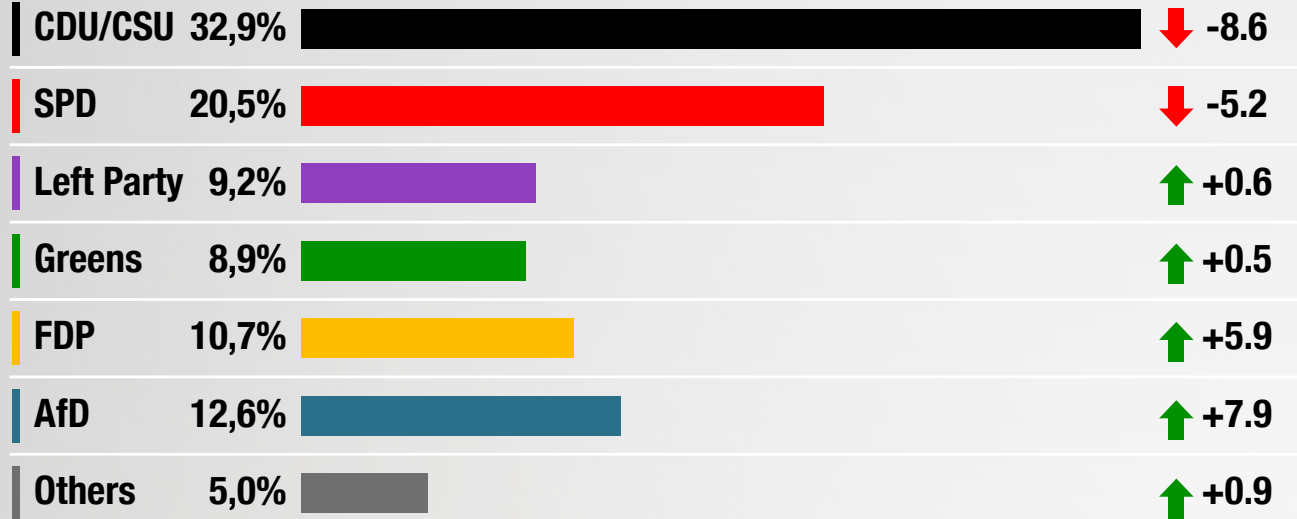
*The outcome of the elections in the Federal State of Lower Saxony (October 15) will influence the explanatory talks and may thus delay coalition negotiations.
